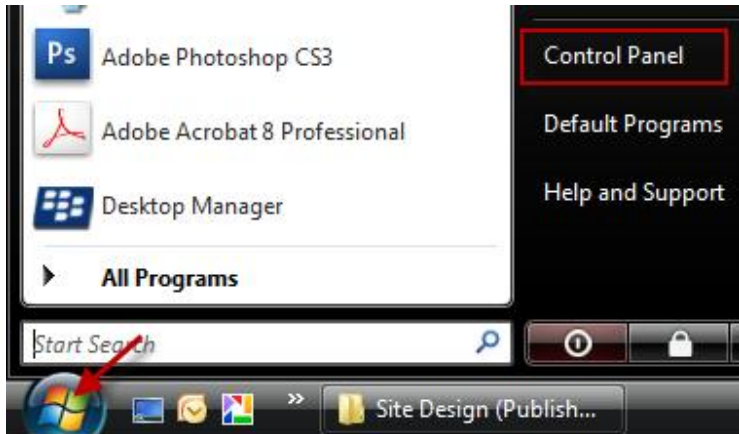
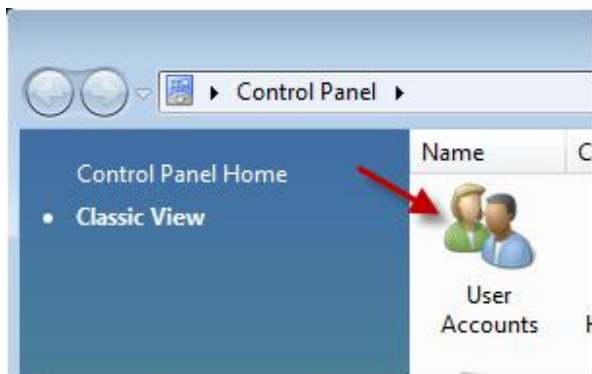


How to disable UAC (User Account Control) in Windows Vista

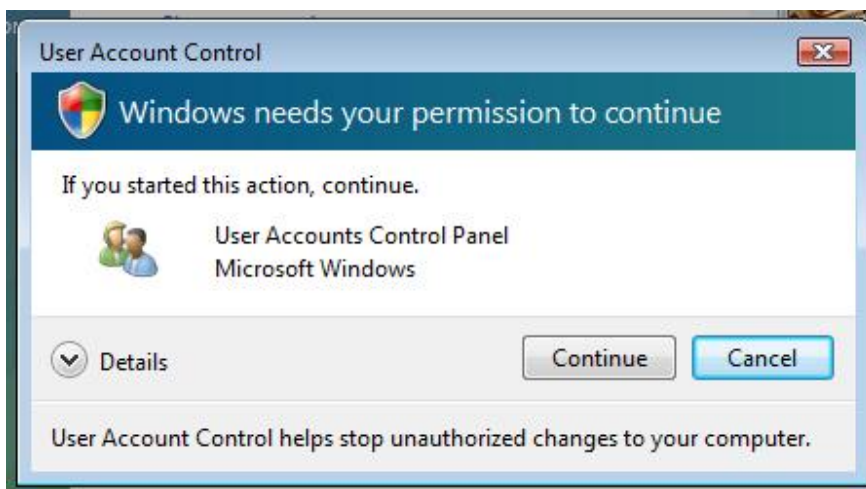
Step 1: Click on **Start** button and click on **Control Panel**



Step 2: Double-click to open **User Accounts**



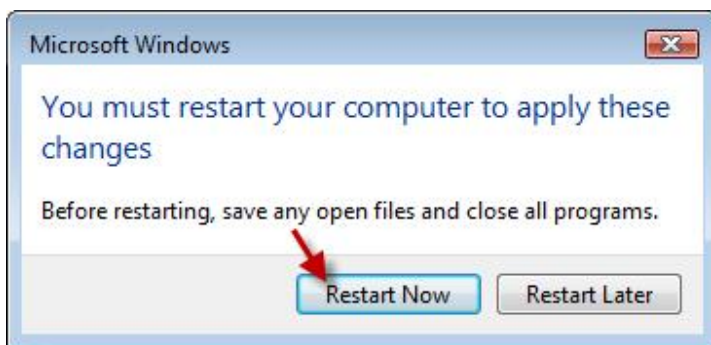
Step 3: Click on the **Turn User Account Control on or off** link



Step 4: The **User Account Control** warning window will appear, grant permission to this operation by clicking on **Continue**.



Step 5: Uncheck the **Use User Account...** to disable UAC and click **OK**, to enable UAC make sure that you add a checkmark to the checkbox.



Step 6: In order for the changes to take effect your computer must be restarted, click **Restart Now** to restart your computer.

*Note: If you wish to continue using your computer, click **Restart Later**. A warning will appear in your notification area when you disable UAC*
