
1. Click the Start Button and chose Control Panel:




2. Click the "Clock, Language and Region" option.




3. Select Change keyboards or other input methods.




4. That will bring up the Keyboard and Languages tab in the Regional and Language Options dialogue. Click the Change keyboards... button:



5. In "Text Services and Input Languages" dialog box you have to check if you have all needed input languages with the appropriate keyboard layouts in the list, otherwise click Add... to add missing languages and/or keyboard layouts.



6. You should now see the "Add Input Language" dialog box. Scroll down to the appropriate language entry, expand it and select the appropriate keyboard layout:



7. Click the "OK" button. You should end up with the appropriate language/keyboard entry(ies) added under "Installed Services". Finally click the "OK" button to exit dialog and save your changes.
